

Dear Parents,

This year we will be using a colored “clip chart” to monitor student behavior and classroom choices. Your child will have a clip on a chart that he/she will physically move up or down the chart, depending on his/her choices.

Please keep in mind that your child may not move every single day. Remaining on green throughout the day represents your child is ready to learn and making good choices. In order to move up, students must go above and beyond in their behavior choices. The chart below explains how the clip chart works.

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| Pink Outstanding! | Students who reach the pink level will be rewarded for their positive choices. |
| Purple Great Job! | Students who continue to make positive choices move up to the purple level. They are one step closer to having outstanding classroom behavior. |
| Blue Good Day! | Making good choices will help students move to the blue section of the clip chart. |
| Green Ready to Learn! | Everyone starts the day “Ready to Learn”! Students can “clip up” or “clip down” throughout the day depending on their behavior choices. |
| Yellow Think About It! | Students who receive a second warning will move to yellow. A verbal warning has been given to students as a reminder prior to moving to yellow. Yellow serves as a reminder for students to think about the choices they make. |
| Orange Focus Room | Students who continue to make poor choices, will move to orange. This will |

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| | result in loss of a portion of “free choice”. Students will be asked to complete a “Think Sheet” and reflect on their choices. |
| Red Parent Contact | Students who move to red will miss a privileged activity. Parents will be contacted. |
